



On Sunday, **4th August 1918**, the fourth anniversary of the declaration of war, King George V and Queen Mary joined members of the House of Commons and the House of Lords for a special service at the Church of Saint Margaret, Westminster.

The King had asked that **4th August 1918** should be observed as a **National Day of Prayer**: 100 days later the war ended.



100 years' later, on **4th August 2018**, churches across the country, across the spectrum of denominations, start **100 days of prayer, peace and reconciliation**.
